

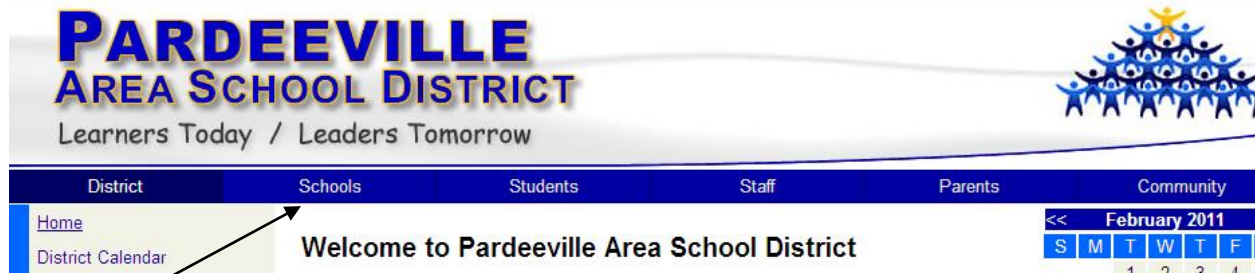
2017-2018 Local Area Scholarship Opportunities

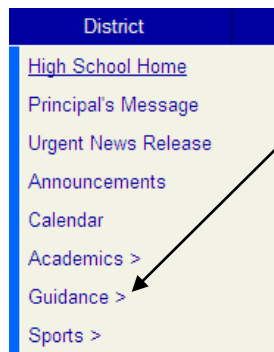

Anonymous Scholarship (Community Application)—One \$1,000 scholarship is offered to graduating high school seniors based on financial need and preference will be given to a 2-yr or Tech School applicant. Application deadline is April 2, 2018.

Ann J. Achterberg Memorial Scholarship (Community Application)—Several scholarships are open to graduating seniors of Pardeeville High School. Funds will be given upon successful completion of the first semester and proof of second consecutive semester enrollment of a 2- or 4-year program of study. Application deadline is April 2, 2018.

Aaron W. Babcock Memorial Scholarship (Community Application)—One \$250 scholarship shall be awarded to a senior who has participated in Cross Country, Basketball, and/or Track and has exhibited excellence in the classroom. Application deadline is April 2, 2018.

Barb Biddick Memorial Scholarship (Community Application)—This scholarship is offered to graduating high school seniors based on financial need, academic standing and community participation. A total of \$3,000 will be distributed to recipients. Funds will be given to the students upon successful proof of enrollment of the first semester in an institution of higher learning. Application deadline April 2, 2018.

The Tammy Cornford Memorial Scholarship (Community Application)—One \$500 scholarship will be awarded upon successful completion of the first semester and proof of second consecutive semester enrollment of a 2-or 4-year college. Preference will be given to a student having demonstrated active participation in our music and/or athletic program. Application deadline is April 2, 2018.

Crawford Oil and Propane “Fueling for Success” Music Scholarship (Community Application)—One \$2,000 scholarship (\$500 paid each fall semester for four years) to a graduating senior who has been accepted into a 4-year college or university intending to major in music performance, music education, or music-related field. Demonstration of financial need will be evaluated. Application deadline April 2, 2018.

Ft. Winnebago Masonic Lodge #33 Scholarship (Community Application)—One \$1,000 scholarship for a trade/technical school and two \$1,000 scholarships for a university/college are available to Pardeeville graduates and payable upon proof of matriculation. Application deadline is April 2, 2018.

The We Hart Junk Skilled Labor Scholarship (Community Application)— A \$250 scholarship is open to graduating senior students who plan on joining the workforce as a skilled laborer (electrical, plumbing, construction, welding, or another type of skilled labor). Funds will be given to the recipient in form of a ‘gift-card’ to a store (ex. Fleet Farm, Menards, Ace Hardware, etc.) to purchase tools, supplies, uniforms, boots, etc. A list of necessary items (tools, supplies, uniforms, etc.) that are needed to join the skilled labor force should be included in an essay. The essay should include why the applicant has chosen to join the workforce, including their strengths and skills that are suited for their career choice. Also included in the essay should be the materials and tools needed to join a skilled labor position. Application deadline is April 2, 2018. **The essay is in lieu of the ‘Personal Statement’ on the Community Application.**

Glenn Miller Kamrath Memorial Scholarship (Community Application)—Two \$250-scholarship will be awarded to high school graduating seniors after proof of 1st semester completion and enrollment for 2nd semester of a 2- or 4-year college. Application deadline April 2, 2018.

Edward C. and June M. Lenz Scholarship (Community Application)— A \$500 scholarship payable upon proof of completion of the first semester and proof of second consecutive semester enrollment in a 2- or 4-year program of study. Open to Pardeeville graduates who plan to study business or finance in a 2- or 4-year course of study. Criteria are achievement in business classes, academic achievement and community service. Application deadline is April 2, 2018.

National Exchange Bank & Trust Scholarship (Community Application)—One recipient to receive a \$500 scholarship to be used at an accredited public or private college, university or vocational school. Applicant should qualify as low to moderate family income. Funds are distributed upon submission of transcripts reflecting a minimum 2.0 cumulative grade point average during the first academic semester after the scholarship is awarded. National Exchange Bank & Trust current employees, members of its board, participants in bank affiliated organizations and immediate family members of the aforementioned are not eligible. Application deadline is April 2, 2018.

Pardeeville Area Business Association (Community Application)—Two scholarships in the amount of \$500 each will be awarded to Pardeeville High School graduates. Payment is issued upon successful completion of the first semester and proof of second consecutive semester enrollment in a 2- or 4-year program of study. Application deadline is April 2, 2018.

Pardeeville Area Lions Club Scholarship (Community Application)—Two scholarships are offered:

- 1) One \$1,600 scholarship will be awarded for academic performance and community service for a student accepted into a 4-year degree program. The award will be issued to the full-time student in two payments of \$800 upon proof of completion of the first semester and confirmation of next semester enrollment in consecutive years. Application deadline is April 2, 2018.
- 2) One \$500 scholarship will be awarded for academic performance and community service for a student accepted into a 1-year or 2-year technical school degree program. The award will be issued to the full-time student in one payment of \$500 upon proof of completion of the first semester and confirmation of next semester enrollment. Application deadline is April 2, 2018.

Pardeeville Boys Club Scholarship (Community Application)—Two \$500 scholarships will be awarded to graduating seniors of Pardeeville High School. A 2-3 paragraph essay which includes future goals, number of years participating in Boys Club, and community service is required. Funds will be given with proof of first semester enrollment of a 2- or 4-year program of study. Application deadline is April 2, 2018.

Pardeeville Bulldog Support Foundation (Community Application)—The Pardeeville Bulldog Support Foundation Scholarship is offering four (4) \$400 scholarships. This scholarship is offered to students: 1) who participated in extra-curricular activities, 2) maintained a 3.0 GPA minimum, 3) worked with P.B.S. Foundation or like community service projects, 4) no ineligibility for code violations during HS career, and 5) write a 100-150 short essay on how their involvement in service projects has influenced their lives. Application deadline is April 2, 2018.

Pardeeville Curling Club Scholarship (Community Application)—One \$500 scholarship will be awarded to one senior who has participated in the Junior Program, High School Program, and adult leagues, or his/her parent participates(d) in adult leagues. Funds will be given upon successful completion of the first semester and proof of second consecutive semester enrollment of a 2- or 4-year program of study (both semesters must be on a full-time basis). Application deadline is April 2, 2018.

Pardeeville Garden Club Scholarship (Community Application)—One \$500 scholarship is open to all Pardeeville High School seniors planning to pursue a 2- or 4-year degree in college. Preference will be given to students studying Horticulture, Agriculture, Forestry, Landscape Architecture and Design, Conservation or a related field. The scholarship will be paid upon completion of the first semester and proof of second consecutive semester enrollment in a 2- or 4-year program of study. Application deadline is April 2, 2018.

Pardeeville Girls Club Scholarship (Community Application)—Two \$250 scholarships will be awarded to graduating seniors of Pardeeville High School. An eligibility criterion is community service. Funds will be given upon successful completion of the first semester and proof of second consecutive semester enrollment of a 2- or 4-year program of study. Application deadline is April 2, 2018.

Pardeeville High School Student Council Scholarship (Community Application)—One \$250 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating student council member of PHS. Funds will be given upon successful completion of the first semester and proof of second consecutive semester enrollment of a 2- or 4-year program of study. A separate essay on how your involvement in Student Council has impacted your life is required. Application deadline is April 2, 2018.

Pine Playhouse Child Care Center Scholarship (Community Application)—One \$150 scholarship will be awarded to a student who attended the Pine Playhouse for a minimum of nine months. Recipient entering a child-oriented field of education will be given first consideration. The scholarship will be given upon successful completion of first semester with proof of second semester enrollment. Application deadline is April 2, 2018.

Margo and Barry Pufahl Scholarship (Community Application)—One \$1,000 scholarship awarded to a graduating student with a cumulative grade point of 3.0 or better and planning to pursue a 4-year degree to enter the teaching profession on a full-time basis. Award will be issued upon the successful completion of the first semester, with proof of second semester registration (both semesters must be on a full-time basis). Application deadline is April 2, 2018.

The Irma Radl Memorial Scholarship (Community Application)—One \$320 scholarship will be awarded upon successful completion of the first semester and proof of second consecutive semester enrollment of a 2-or 4-year college. Application deadline is April 2, 2018.

St. Vincent de Paul Society (Community Application)—Graduating seniors will be eligible to receive one \$500 scholarship. Award will be based on financial need, academic standing and community participation. One check in the amount of \$500 will be given to a student once he/she has completed their first semester in an institution of higher learning and submits proof of enrollment in second semester studies. Application deadline is April 2, 2018.

Sara R. Smith Memorial Scholarship (Community Application)—One \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a student who plans on pursuing a 4-year degree in Elementary Education or an early childhood child-oriented field of education (emphasis in reading/storytelling). Award will be issued upon the successful completion of the first semester, with proof of second semester enrollment. Application deadline is April 2, 2018.

United Community Bank (Community Application)—One \$1,000 scholarship payable upon proof of completion of the first semester and proof of second consecutive semester enrollment in a 2- or 4-year program of study. Open to Pardeeville graduates who plan to study business or finance in a 2- or 4-year course of study. Criteria are achievement in business classes, academic achievement and community service. Application deadline is April 2, 2018.

[Divine Savior Healthcare Academic Scholarship Program](#) (Divine Savior Healthcare-\$1,000, The Partners of Divine Savior Healthcare-\$1,500 & \$500, & Divine Savior Medical Staff-\$1,000):

Divine Savior Healthcare—“This scholarship is awarded to promote and encourage the academic preparation for a career in healthcare. The award encourages the attainment of the highest level of professional performance in healthcare. This is a one time, non-renewable scholarship.” Deadline is April 6, 2018.

The Partners of Divine Savior Healthcare—“Our \$1,500 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating high school senior or a current student who has completed at least one semester of study and who is pursuing a healthcare degree at a four-year college or university. This award is paid in two installments of \$750 each. Our \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a student seeking an associate’s degree in a healthcare related.

[The Pardeeville FFA Alumni Scholarship](#)—Two scholarships will be awarded for \$300 each, and will be payable upon the completion of the first semester of college or vocational school. Applicant must be a senior from Pardeeville High School and an FFA member, be accepted to an accredited university, college, or vocational school, and have maintained a satisfactory scholastic record in school. Application deadline: Must be in guidance office prior to April 7, 2018 (Saturday).

[Portage Area Community Theatre Scholarship](#)—A \$500 scholarship is open to any deserving senior who has been involved in the art and plans to continue their education. Although preference will be given to those who will major in some form of the arts, it is not a requirement. Application deadline is April 7, 2018

[Technical Excellence Scholarship](#)—Technical Excellence Scholarships are to be awarded to Wisconsin high school seniors who have the highest demonstrated level of proficiency in technical education subjects and attend a Wisconsin Technical College. Application is due in the guidance office April 9, 2018.

[Columbia County Farm Bureau Scholarship](#)—\$300 scholarships are offered to high school graduating seniors. The only requirement is that the student’s parent must **hold a current Membership in Columbia County Farm Bureau**. Applications are accepted from students who are furthering their education in a College, Technical, Trade School, or Short Course and do not need to be majoring in an Agricultural field. Completed applications must be in the Portage Office by April 10, 2018.

[Jon Steinhaus Line Worker Scholarship Program](#)—“Anyone who is a high school senior or older is encouraged to apply. Enrollment in an Electrical Power Distribution (EPD) program at a certified EPD school in the United States is required. Preference will be given to members of Adams-Columbia Electric Cooperative. Visit Adams-Columbia Electric Cooperative, click Co-op Programs, then Scholarship Programs.” Application is available on-line March 1, 2018 through April 13, 2018.

[The Pardeeville FFA Alumni Scholarship](#)—Two scholarships will be awarded for \$300 each, and will be payable upon the completion of the first semester of college or vocational school. Applicant must be a senior from Pardeeville High School and an FFA member, be accepted to an accredited university, college, or vocational school, and have maintained a satisfactory scholastic record in school. Application deadline: Must be in guidance office prior to April 15, 2018 (Sunday).

[Sgt. Don Marine Scholarship](#)—The scholarship is available to an applicant who is or have been an at-risk student or have another learning disability as defined by the Pardeeville school district. This scholarship will provide a scholarship to one student in the amount of \$500 for up to four years (possible total of \$2,000 if the student is

selected to receive scholarship awards for up to four years of college). The winning student must re-apply with transcripts to be considered for successive years. Application deadline is April 15, 2018.

2018 Kwik Trip Family Scholarship Program—“Kwik Trip Family Scholarships are awarded to eligible Kwik Trip co-workers or children of Kwik Trip co-workers. Each scholarship is \$2000. Deadline for applications is April 30, 2018.

Vietnam Veterans of America, Chapter 221—Two \$500 scholarships are available to several area high school seniors. Scholarships will be awarded after completion of one semester at a facility of higher education. Scholarship is open to student who is a child, grandchild, niece or nephew of an honorable discharged veteran who has served in any branch of the service between January 1, 1959 and May 7, 1975. Applicants must be submitted no later than April 15, 2018.

Visual Arts Scholarship—“The Visual Arts Scholarship, dedicated to the support of a visual arts student pursuing an art degree or its equivalent after high school, is made possible by a generous gift from Eleanor Drury.” Visit their website for more information and an application. Deadline is April 15, 2018.

Marcellon-Courtland-Springvale Mutual Insurance Company Scholarship—Applicant’s parent/guardian must have a Marcellon Courtland-Springvale Mutual Insurance Company policy in force one year prior to application deadline. The applicant must be a Freshman/Sophomore in college or a graduating Senior or GED equivalent (in current year) and has maintained a 2.75 high school GPA. More information is available on the application. Application must be received by or postmarked by April 30th of the current year.

W-ski’s Casting Scholarship—A former student of Pardeeville High School is offering two (2) scholarships for \$400 to seniors attending Pardeeville High School. Eligible students need to maintain a 3.0 or higher Cum GPA and submit a 1,000-word or more essay (about yourself, why you would like & need this, and what it will do for you and your career). Email your essay to wskicasting@gmail.com. Subject box: Scholarship 2016. Student must enroll in one of the following programs: TV, Film, or Media at any college in the Wisconsin area. Funds will be given upon proof of enrollment. Deadline is April 30, 2018.

Columbia County Deputy Sheriff’s Association Scholarship—“The Columbia County Deputy Sheriffs Association annual scholarship award program was developed to offer financial assistance to full-time students enrolled in Criminal Justice programs at any Wisconsin college or university. Its purpose is to encourage educational growth and professionalism among police officers and deputy sheriffs in the State of Wisconsin and more specifically, Columbia County. Two, \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded and winners will be selected on a competitive basis. Any Columbia County resident that is enrolling in a Wisconsin college, and has a course of study leading to a degree in a law enforcement related field, is eligible. Scholarship applications must be postmarked no later than May 1, 2018.”

Pardeeville American Legion Auxiliary Scholarship—One \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a direct or adopted descendant or step-descendant of an honorably discharged Veteran who served in the Armed Forces of the United States of America. **Proof is required.** More information is on the application. **Application must be completed and submitted on or before May 1, 2018.**

Steve Thomas Memorial Scholarship—One \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a senior planning to enter one of the following programs in a **technical school**: Diesel and Heavy Equipment Technician; Motorcycle, Marine and Outdoor Products; Welding; Agriculture Equipment Technology. Related Programs will also be considered. **Award will be issued upon the successful completion of the first semester, with proof of second semester registration.** Deadline is May 1, 2018.

Crawford Oil and Propane Valedictorian Scholarship—One \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded to the Valedictorian (no application needed). Award will be issued upon proof of completion of the first semester and enrollment of second consecutive semester.

Steve Thomas Salutatorian Scholarship—One \$500 scholarship will be awarded to the Salutatorian (no application needed). **Award will be issued upon the successful completion of the first semester, with proof of second semester registration.**
