The ideal candidate to lead Pardeeville Middle School will foster academic excellence, leading, developing, and empowering all members of the school staff and communicating effectively with parents, students, members of the community, and colleagues. In addition, the middle school principal is responsible for creating inclusive learning environments, curriculum development, program evaluation, personnel management, financial management, and emergency procedures in their building and for the school district.

Qualifications:

The ideal candidate will support and motivate students and staff in their continued growth and development, as well as work with the administrative team to provide quality leadership. Preferred experiences include:
