# MINUTES REGULAR BOARD MEETING January 3, 2011

#### Approval of Fund Raising Projects for Teens in Action

Mr. Burmeister said proposed costs for the years 2011, 2012 and 2013 would be equivalent to the costs we paid in 2008, 2009 and 2010 to ProStar. Mr. Billman made a motion to approve the ProStar contract as written for three years. Ms. Pufahl seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

#### Approval of Donation from Bank of Poynette

A donation of \$500 from the Bank of Poynette was submitted to the Board for approval. Mr. Knitt recommended this donation be put toward technology for the school. Ms. Levzow made a motion to approve the donation from Bank of Poynette and that it be put toward technology. Mr. Balsiger seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0. Mr. Knitt will send a thank you to the Bank of Poynette for their donation.
